



Oklahoma Hall of Fame

Please read the following requirements carefully in order for your nominee to be considered.

NOMINATIONS

Induction into the Oklahoma Hall of Fame is the highest honor any Oklahoman can receive from the state. Any individual or corporation may submit a nomination for consideration. Nominations must be postmarked or delivered to the Oklahoma Heritage Association & Gaylord-Pickens Museum no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 2, 2012.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Please download the nomination form from the Association's Web site at www.oklahomaheritage.com or contact the Oklahoma Heritage Association at 405.235.4458.
2. Nominations must be typed.
3. The space provided must be used to include major points as to why the individual should be selected for induction into the Oklahoma Hall of Fame, including but not limited to the areas of: education, business and professional affiliations, awards or special recognitions, philanthropic involvement and volunteerism, and leadership positions. Please make reference to the individual's ties to Oklahoma as well as his or her unique talents in his or her field.
4. No more than four (4) letters of recommendation will be permitted per nominee.
5. A vita or resume is recommended in support of the nomination. However, the Oklahoma Heritage Association is unable to accept videos, books, or pictures.

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees eligible for election to the Oklahoma Hall of Fame must be living, a resident of Oklahoma or a former resident of the state; shall have performed outstanding service to humanity, to the state of Oklahoma and to the United States, be known for their public service throughout the state; or the individual may be a person, although not a resident of Oklahoma, who shall be imminently distinguished in their profession or in literature, science, arts/humanities, industry, statesmanship or military affairs, in which their public service shall have brought honor or distinction to Oklahoma or have contributed to the state's heritage.

INDUCTION CEREMONY

The 85th annual Oklahoma Hall of Fame will be held during the month of November in Tulsa.

In addition to this application, you may attach a narrative summary, no more than a two (2) pages in length, of specific contributions the nominee has made to humanity, the state of Oklahoma and the United States.

Even if the nominee you are presenting is very well known, please present all pertinent information about the nominee as if the committee is completely unfamiliar with his or her accomplishments.
