Westmoore senior receives \$10,000 scholarship

[Andrew Parker](#), a Westmoore senior, has received a \$10,000 John W. and [Mary Nichols](#) Scholarship from the [Oklahoma Heritage Association](#). Thirteen [Oklahoma County](#) high school students received scholarships or tuition grants.

Each year the association awards more than \$400,000 in such assistance, with the \$10,000 scholarship going to a senior who demonstrates extensive knowledge of and appreciation for Oklahoma history.

Nominees must excel in academics, citizenship and leadership and commit to attending an Oklahoma college or university.

[Parker](#) has completed 165 hours volunteering for the [Oklahoma History Center](#) and participates in Civil War re-enactments. He placed first in world history and in American democracy at the Interscholastic Meet at [Southeastern Oklahoma State University](#).

At Westmoore, he participates in speech and debate and has served in leadership roles for the [National Honor Society](#).
