## “Teaching Inquiry Through Primary Sources”

This four-day intensive summer institute will:

- Teach strategies for developing inquiry-based lessons aligned to *PASS* standards using primary sources.
- Demonstrate how to identify and locate online primary sources from the Library of Congress, Oklahoma Department of Libraries, Oklahoma Heritage Association, Oklahoma History Center, and more.
- Prepare educators to train others to use online primary sources in the classroom.
- Support the creation of a collection of shared lesson plans.
- Include visits to the Oklahoma Heritage Association, Oklahoma History Center, and the Oklahoma Department of Libraries to view and learn more about collections available to schools.

The Library Media Section of the Oklahoma State Department of Education is partnering with the Library of Congress (LOC), Oklahoma Department of Libraries (ODL), and the Oklahoma Heritage Association (OHA) to provide this opportunity to enhance curricular activities. By the end of the summer institute, participants will be familiar with the digitized primary sources of the Library of Congress, as well as local Oklahoma resources, and will understand their value in instruction. Participants will create inquiry-based lessons supporting Oklahoma's *PASS* standards.
